AVA Capital Partners Limited ("we" or "us" or "our" or "AVA CAP") is a principal investment firm that provides innovative financial solutions and Issuing House services (the "Services") in Nigeria. We are committed to protecting the privacy of our users ("your" or "you") online and in real time. This Privacy Policy describes your privacy rights regarding our collection, use, storage, sharing, and protection of your personal information, including but not limited to your personal identifiers, electronic network activity information, professional information, location information, and other types of information described below and on our website at https://avacapitalgroup.com/ (the "Website").

AVA CAP uses the following methods to collect and securely store your personal information:

- Website
- Online forms
- Cookies
- Physical forms
- Know Your Customer (KYC) documents

1. WHAT DATA WE COLLECT

- 1.1 Personal data or personal information refers to information about an individual from which such person can be identified. Such data include your first name, last name, username or similar identifier, title, date of birth, and gender, including residential address, email address, and telephone number(s).
- 1.2 Financial data, including but not limited to records of your account transactions, including payment records received from third-party payment gateways or credit agencies.
- 1.3 Human resources data, which includes information relating to your employment history, as well as the professional and educational details you provided when applying for employment with us.
- 1.4 Technical data, which includes internet protocol (IP) address, domain name, your login data, browser type and version, time zone setting and location, browser plug-

HOW WE USE PERSONAL DATA

2.1 Our lawful basis for utilising personal information

We will only use and process your personal data as permitted by the Nigerian Data Protection Act 2023 and any applicable implementation Framework issued by the Nigeria Data Protection Commission.

When you use our Services, particularly on our Website, your geographic location, how you use the Services, information about the type of device you use, your Open Device Identification Number, date/time stamps for your visit, your unique device identifier, your browser type, operating system, Internet Protocol (IP) address, and domain name are all collected.

In general, the personal information you submit to us is used to respond to requests made, assist us in serving you better, or market our Services. We use your personal information in the following ways:

We may also create anonymous data records from your personal information by completely excluding information (such as your name) that makes the data personally identifiable to you. We use this anonymous data to analyse requests and usage patterns so that we may enhance the content of our Services and improve Website



functionality. We reserve the right to use anonymous data for any purpose and disclose anonymous data to third parties at our sole discretion.

We may receive testimonials and comments from users who have had positive experiences with our Services, and publish such content. When we publish this content, we may identify our users by their first and last names. We obtain the user's consent before posting this set of information along with the testimonial.

COOKIES

Our Website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Website. "Cookies" are small pieces of information (text files) that a website sends to your computer's hard drive while you are viewing the Website.
